Dr. Barb is an ASH Certified Hypertension Specialist and he joined The Cardiac & Vascular Institute in 2014.




Ferenc Győry

Ulf Jensen

Dr. Jensen has a double specialty: cardiac surgery and interventional cardiology. He has been doing PCI since 2002 and has been a senior consultant and head of cath lab and ischemic heart disease at South General hospital since 2015.

Dr. Jensem has a PhD in simulation in PCI training and has been doing complex PCI since 2007 doing rotablation and started the CTO program at Karolinska University hopsital in 2009. Working at the Södersjukhuset/South General Hospital in Stockholm, Sweden, since 2013.

He was an official CTO proctor for Boston 2014-2016 to promote the Bridgepopint technique. His other interest lies in complex PCI, the more complex the more fun! He is also performing LAAC, alcohol septal ablation and implant REDUCER device.

Because of his history in cardiac surgery he's also used to canulate and initiate ECMO.

Peep Laanmets

Born in Estonia in 1977, Dr. Laanmets graduated Tartu University in 2001. He is a licensed cardiologist since 2006 and has a interventional cardiology certificate from Estonian Cardiology Society 2008.

Dr. Laanmets is Past President of Estonian Society of Cardiology (2015-2018) and leader of CTO program in North-Estonia Medical Centre.

He is performing about 400-450 PCI's and 60-80 CTO-s annually and proctoring CTO procedures as freelancer.

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Kambis Mashayekhi

Deputy Senior Consultant Cardiology and Angiology II of the University Heart-Center Bad Krozingen, Germany, and Director of the CTO and CHIP Program.

The spectrum of cardiovascular interventions include: Chronic Total Occlusions (CTO 350 per year), Top 3 in Europe (www.ercto.org), Coronary high-risk PCI with left ventricular support, Rotablation (70 per year), IVUS controlled Left Main stenting, Treatment of challenging coronary multivessel diseases, TAVI-Implants (50 annually going back to 2010 to 2016).

Dr Mashayekhi is also a reviewer for JACC, JACC CV Interventions, Journal Critical Care, Catheter Cardiovascular Interventions.





Dr. Råmunddal is an interventional cardiologist specialized in complex PCI and CTO. He was trained in cardiology and interventional cardiology at Sahlgrenska University Hospital, Gothenburg, Sweden.

He has been deeply involved in CTO education in Sweden and is frequently requested as proctor for CTO in the Nordics and across Europe.

Zoltán Ruzsa

Angiologist and Cardiologist, is an Associate Professor at Semmelweis University, Cardiac and Vascular Center and Head of Invasive Cardiology at Bács-Kiskun County Hospital.

Currently the president of the Hungarian Association of Cardio-Vascular Interventions. He is expert in doing complex coronary (CTO, LM, rotational atherectomy) and peripheral procedures (carotide, subclavian, renal, venous and lower limb interventions).

He is principal investigator in many international and investigator initiated trials in interventional cardiology and angiology field.
